## 2019-2020 Student Fees Herron High School and Riverside High School

The following are the breakfast and lunch prices. If the full tray is not purchased as defined below, a la carte prices will be charged. A la carte charges are not covered by the National Free & Reduced Lunch Program.

Breakfast Tray – includes entrée, fruit, juice & milk	\$2.15	\$.40

(Any additional full trays purchase are at full pay regardless of lunch status)

A flat fee has been assessed for **TEXTBOOK FEES** for the core classes that all students take. This fee includes math, science, social studies, English and Latin classes. The fee has been assessed by grade level.

SUPPLY FEE \$80 Full Pay

\$50 Free & Reduced

The Supply Fee includes a lab fees for Science, Music and Art classes. It also covers the costs of the student planner and ID. The State of Indiana funds a portion of consumable supply fees for students eligible for Free & Reduced Lunch.

A \$25 discount is offered on the Supply Fee for families that pay ALL fees in full by December 31, 2019. The entire balance must be paid in full to receive the discount.
